

ICHART ENHANCED MENTAL HEALTH SCREENING TOOL

The iCHART enhanced mental health screening tool is a brief (7 minutes average) set of surveys administered to the caregiver and adolescent, independently. It is designed to facilitate shared decision making about treatment options and mental health supports between adolescents, caregivers, and primary care providers. Each screen includes questions about:

- adolescent's mental health (worries, mood changes, substance use);
- adolescent and caregiver's mental health treatment preferences, readiness, and barriers;
- adolescent's current treatment use and satisfaction, if applicable

Screening Facts

Accessible

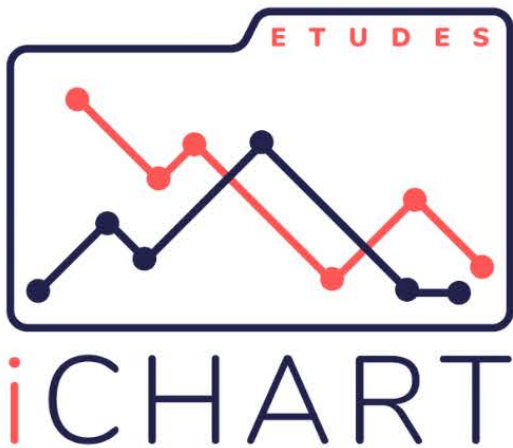
Highlights barriers and treatment preferences that primary care providers can incorporate into their recommendations

Individualized

Identifies other important factors to consider when managing depressive and suicidal symptoms
Shows differences in adolescent and caregiver opinions that can start a meaningful conversation
